Because the City revised the Emblem contract, the Judge lifted the stay on the copays. This means that beginning January 2025, we will most likely see copays. There is no ending date to the contract, it expires when the City goes to change it. This is another gift of the MLC under the leadership of DC37 and the UFT, and its chair Harry Nespoli. Copays in this contract are \$15. We will keep you posted when more information comes out of OLR on these changes. But please be patient, as the meat and potatoes of the case has not yet been argued. This is just the stay that has been lifted... and the City has not put out anything on this yet, but since open enrollment is around the corner - we will be watching.


Every September, eligible retirees and beneficiaries receive a Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) to


their retirement allowance that is based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI). WHAT IS THE 2024 COLA RATE?

The 2024 Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) for eligible retirees and beneficiaries is 1.8%.

If you are eligible to receive COLA, it will be reflected in your September 30, 2024 Pension Payment.

Comes out to \$27.00 per month

#### FEATURED - <u>PRESS CENTER</u> GOA LAWSUIT FORCES NYC TO ALLOW NON-RESIDENTS TO APPLY FOR CARRY PERMITS Written by <u>Walter Smoloski</u> Published: 09 August 2024

Washington, D.C. — Yesterday, the New York City Police Department adopted an emergency rule which will allow non-residents to apply for concealed carry permits. This follows a lawsuit filed by Gun Owners of America (GOA) and the Gun Owners Foundation (GOF) in February of this year on behalf of several non-residents (including Newsmax TV Host Carl Higbie) who have been wholly unable to secure any type of carry permit in New York, leaving them defenseless.

Erich Pratt, GOA's Senior Vice President, issued the following statement:

"This is great news for the untold millions of Americans who either work or visit New York every year. It's critical that everyone can exercise their inherent right to self-defense, but until now, anti-gunners in New York denied most Americans that basic right.

"We will continue to monitor local cases to ensure that NYPD indeed grants these permits to applicants in a timely and non-onerous manner. Otherwise, we will gladly file another lawsuit directed specifically at Mayor Adams and the NYPD."

Background: Under current New York law, only New York residents, or those who primarily work in New York, may apply for and obtain permits to carry concealed weapons, and the state does not grant any form of reciprocity for individuals who hold a similar permit from another state.

As a result, those who hold out of state driver's licenses may drive in New York, but the exercising of one's constitutional right to bear arms in New York State is wholly inaccessibly to the 94% of Americans who are not New York State residents. New York is one of a very few states where nonresidents are not allowed to exercise their Second Amendment rights to keep and bear arms.

GOA spokesmen are available for interviews. Gun Owners of America is a nonprofit grassroots lobbying organization dedicated to protecting the right to keep and bear arms without compromise. GOA represents over two million members and activists. For more information, visit GOA's Press Center.

#### **Retiree Program**

In 2006, POPPA started its Retiree Program. The program began with 26 retired NYPD officers dedicated to help meet the needs of fellow retired police officers. The mental health and other unique needs of this group are often overlooked. Retired police officers can use POPPA services for a variety of stress or mental health issues, relationship problems, substance use, or if they feel suicidal. Sometimes, retirees just need to reconnect with another person who can identify as a law enforcement peer.

The Retiree Program has grown to more than 100 volunteers spanning several states across the country in addition to New York.
